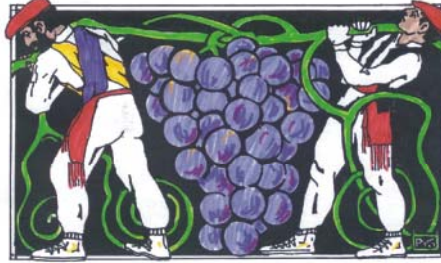


CHANGALA



Changala Winery 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon Paso Robles

The grapes for this wine come from two east Paso vineyards. One is the silver Horse Vineyard and the other is the Alguas Dias vineyard. There is also a small amount of Malbec (about 9%) in the final blend. The Malbec grapes come from a vineyard on the east side of Paso behind Meridian Vineyards. The juice was gently pumped over the skins to ensure maximum color and flavor extraction. The must was fermented to dryness in the tank and the pomace was then shoveled into small bins and gently returned to the press with minimum mechanical handling. The new wine then went into small oak barrels, mostly neutral and some new American oak. This wine is full bodied with intense flavors of ripe cherry and spiced oak. Its rich, balanced flavor expresses the characters of the vineyard. The wine is unfiltered.
